

Environment and Energy Statement of Intent

InHealth are committed to reducing their environmental impact and energy usage within the healthcare industry. By implementing an environment and energy policy, the organisation commits to managing its diagnostic and screening activities in a manner that protects the environment, prevents pollution, reduces energy usage and minimises the impact of its operations.

The organisation is dedicated to the continual improvement of its environment and energy performance and will set clear and attainable objectives and targets to facilitate compliance with this policy.

- Promote environmental awareness to all relevant persons working for and on behalf of the organisation and train them in their responsibilities by communicating this policy.

- Review this policy and report environmental performance to the Executive Team.

To give the EMS and EnMS purpose and direction, SMART Environmental and Energy objectives are agreed at all levels of the organisation and are regularly reviewed. Objectives include identified risks and opportunities and support our overall organisational strategy.

To ensure that all relevant staff, customers and third parties are aware of the EMS and EnMS, and their responsibilities within it, this policy is displayed and communicated publicly, supported by awareness and training activity.

InHealth are committed to the continued review and improvement of the EMS and EnMS and ensure continued compliance with contractual, legal, and other requirements applicable to the Organisation.
